Sutton, May 15 2015. Founded in 1923 ST&SC is one of the oldest clubs in UK and is one of Surrey's top tennis and squash members clubs. Originally, known as "Sutton Hard Courts", the club's 9 clay courts were a firm favourite amongst international tennis stars throughout the decades. In 1990s the club converted to all-weather hard courts with floodlights.
