Welcome to Maidenhead LTC...

Maidenhead Lawn Tennis Club is one of the oldest tennis clubs in the world dating back to 1879. Situated only 10 minutes from Junction 8/9 of the M4, the club has over 700 playing members and is an LTA Satellite Performance Club with Club Mark accreditation.

This is the 21st year the tournament has been held which, in the past, has attracted players from all over the country. Entry numbers have increased steadily over the past few years and this year's tournament will include all three mini-tennis categories (red, orange and green) to cater for younger players in addition to the usual yellow ball events (12's 14's 16's and 18's).

With the exception of the mini age groups, all main-draw singles categories are grade 3 rankings events. Plate/consolation and doubles events are also staged weather permitting.

The club has 6 tarmacadam all-weather courts and 6 porous acrylic courts. Additional courts will be used at Newlands Girls School. Full changing facilities are available in the modern clubhouse and refreshments will be served all day with hot food available as well as snacks.

We invite your application and look forward to welcoming you to Maidenhead Lawn Tennis Club for our 2010 competition.

Information

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association and shall be conducted in accordance with their rules and those published by the organising committee.
2. All competitors for ALL events shall be members of the British Tennis Membership scheme. An LTA rating is also required for all singles events.
3. A refund will be made to any competitor withdrawing from an event, prior to the published cancellation deadlines. Where payment has been made by credit or debit card then a 10% deduction will be applied to cover processing costs. Cancellation deadline for all singles applications is 10:00am on Monday 29/03/10.
4. Each player shall be responsible for finding out when they are required to play and must make contact with the referee by telephoning 08712 779 819 if they have received no notification 48 hours before the start of the competition.
5. The committee of a tournament may decline to accept any application.
6. Where any main draw singles event is oversubscribed then the higher rated players will be selected first. Players of equal rating will be merited according to their LTA ranking as at the closing deadline. Players of equal rating and ranking will be split according to application date/time.
7. Wild cards may be awarded at the discretion of the committee.
8. Applications may be made by post, fax or via the tournament website **www.tennisuk.net**. Telephone applications & applications without payment cannot be accepted.
9. Cheques relating to players who are not accepted for the tournament will be automatically shredded 10 days after the conclusion of the competition unless an SAE is received for their return within this time.
10. Players shall be considered available throughout the published dates and times of play, unless specifically agreed by the tournament referee, prior to the closing deadline.
11. Some matches may be played at Newlands School, Farm Road, Maidenhead, Berks SL6 5JB. Other nearby venues may also be used too at the discretion of the management committee.
12. Balls will be provided for all matches. Once-used balls may be employed in certain rounds.
13. Players, parents and tournament visitors are reminded that cars should be parked to the NORTH of the club (adjacent to the cemetery), only. Please do not obstruct neighbours' driveways.
14. The decision of the referee and/or committee on all matters relating to the tournament shall be final.
