

Coronavirus Biohazard Conditions for Tennis Competitions Managed by Tennis Services UK Limited at Bromley Tennis Centre & Aldershot Tennis Centre

The health and wellbeing of players, parents and officials is our highest priority. Players, parents and other tournament visitors are required to understand and follow the following conditions and procedures:

- (1) adhere to HM Government's social distancing guidelines at all times and not to cause or permit any action or behaviour which may increase the risk of Coronavirus transmission
- (2) stay within permitted areas of the venue and to follow the centre's one-way system
- (3) wash your hands more regularly than you typically would and use hand sanitiser when access to running water isn't readily available. Players are asked to bring their own hand sanitiser which should be used on arrival at the centre, before and after each match
- (4) ensure no-one leaves home to participate in tennis if they, or someone they live with, has symptoms of COVID -19
- (5) there should be no skin to skin contact for players. Racket taps are allowed but shaking hands or elbow alternatives are not permitted
- (6) players are asked to bring along no more than ONE accompanying non-participant (e.g. a parent or guardian). Centre staff and/or event officials may refuse admission to anyone in contravention of this provision and have the authority to remove any such additional persons from the facility at their sole discretion
- (7) viewing areas are limited and cannot be guaranteed. No seating will be available for spectators, visitors or players waiting to play matches
- (8) players waiting to play matches, parents, and other visitors should remain socially distanced whilst attending events and spread out, in line with government guidance
- (9) wear face masks or suitable face coverings whilst in the centre. This also applies to players waiting to play but not to players who are on court playing matches
- (10) we aim to provide seats for players to use on-court during matches (during permitted breaks) although this cannot be guaranteed. We strongly recommend that players sanitise these using the anti-bacterial spray and paper cloths which will be supplied.
- (11) the following facilities will NOT be available:
 - a. **Scoreboards.** Scoreboards will not be used. Players shall be expected to call the scores themselves after each point and the set score after each game) and at any other time if required to do so by a tournament official
 - b. **Showers.** No showers are available although toilets and changing rooms will be open. Leaving any belongings in toilets or changing rooms is not permitted
 - c. **Catering facilities.** Catering facilities are limited and (where provided) only contactless methods of payment will be accepted. Players and visitors may bring their own food and drink for consumption on the premises
- (12) these conditions are constantly under review and may be amended at any time without notice, if it is considered reasonable and appropriate to do so
